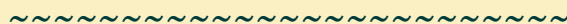

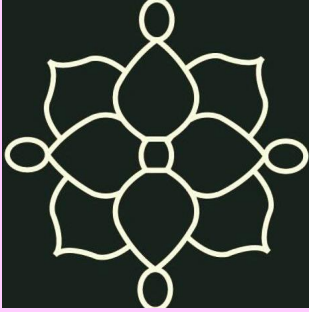

CASTLE ON THE COVE:

The Connecticut State Prison and Wethersfield



The existence of crime has always been present in all societies. In the Colonial Era, it was believed that men were born in sin and severe punishment was needed as a deterrent to crime. A criminal could not be rehabilitated, but they could be frightened into social order. In Jacksonian America, 1820 - 1850, citizens had embraced republican ideals, but crime increased as there was greater movement westward, loosening religious and patriarchal control. Prisons were redesigned at this time to reform offenders through isolation, obedience and routine. It is at this point that the prison at Wethersfield was founded under the Auburn system of isolation and silent reflection. America had founded a new type of penitentiary and Europe closely watched the evolving homegrown invention.

It is the purpose of this exhibit to explore the Connecticut State Prison's history without
